

Flu Programming FAQ

How can Labcorp help me this flu season?

A dedicated Client Success manager will work with you to plan, coordinate, and manage a successful flu campaign. We take care of all the details: promotional materials, a scheduling tool, and reporting.

What type of flu vaccines will be available this year?

We offer quadrivalent vaccines.

Can pregnant women be vaccinated?

Yes. However, it is recommended that they consult with their physician first.

How does Labcorp staff its clinics?

Our on-site vaccinator team is comprised of RNs, LPNs, and other appropriately credentialed healthcare professionals. All staff licenses and certifications are carefully vetted. Staff receive in-depth and ongoing training to ensure compliance and drive participant satisfaction.

How much lead time is required for scheduling?

We request a minimum of six weeks lead time for on-site flu clinics.

How long should the flu clinic last?

Labcorp can administer approximately 15-18 shots per hour, per nurse. For example, if you expect 30 participants, your event should last two hours. We will help you determine the time, staff, and set-up that best fits your workforce.

Should employees have to sign-up for flu shots?

Yes. This helps ensure adequate staff and resources, and minimize wait time.

Who handles registration?

We coordinate scheduling at no additional cost. Online, paper, and telephonic options are available.

What about employees who can't attend an on-site flu clinic?

We offer a flu voucher program, which is a convenient and cost effective alternative to on-site clinics. Vouchers may be redeemed at any designated Walgreens or CVS pharmacy location nationwide (except North Dakota).



Is the same vaccine type available off-site?

Yes, the quadrivalent vaccine is available.

Are off-site appointments necessary?

No, simply take your voucher to a Walgreens or CVS pharmacy. Participants can schedule an appointment at Walgreens using the following links:

Are there any set-up fees or minimums for the flu voucher program?

No.

How will I be charged for the flu voucher program?

You will be invoiced for only the vouchers used (i.e., flu vaccines given).

What is the timeframe to set-up the off-site clinics?

A minimum of four weeks is ideal to set-up the flu voucher program.
